

Red

10. Denis Marchais – Cabernet Sauvignon

A nice deep colour with good tannin structure, moderate acidity and aromas of blackcurrant, tomato leaf, dark spices and cedar wood.

11. Denis Marchais – Merlot

The nose of this wine is bursting with ripe fruit and hints of cocoa and herbs. A rich palate with hints of black cherries and chocolate.

12. Les Vignerons – Carignan Syrah

Brambly fruit and aromatic spices sit nicely on the soft but structured palate.

13. Caleo – Montepulciano D`Abruzzo

Deep ruby red colour with violet highlights and a pleasant and fruity bouquet. Dry, and round on the palate. The finish is full bodied with soft tannins and good acidity.

14. Mountbridge – Reserve Shiraz

This spicy Shiraz exhibits rich aromas of lifted white pepper, dark plum and berries with a medium to full palate.

Rose

15. San Giorgio – Pinot Grigio Rose

Dry

Produced exclusively from Pinot Grigio from Puglia. Dry and well balanced on the palate it has an elegant and lasting fruity bouquet.

16. Les Vignerons – Grenache Merlot

Medium

Light and clean with a delicious strawberries and cream feel.

17. La Roulerie – Rose D`Anjou

Sweet

With a bouquet reminiscent of red berries. The palate is expressive, rich and aromatic with a hint of liquorice and toffee. The clean, fresh and tasty finish is balanced by a fine acidity.

White Wines

- 18. L'Hyverniere – Muscadet sur Lie** **19.50**
The characteristic pale green colour compliments a complex and intense nose. The long finish is dominated by white flower fragrances.
- 19. Neptune – Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc** **22.95**
This New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc is a lovely, fruity and aromatic wine with notes of citrus fruits, gooseberry with a subtle vanilla touch.
- 20. Domaine Terres Gentilles – Macon Lugny** **26.00**
A gem of a find. Nicely balanced with crisp citrus fruit and softer notes of green apples and aromas of white flowers adding delicacy and complexity.
- 21. Domaine Ducroux – Sancerre** **32.00**
A delicious Sauvignon Blanc with its characteristic gooseberry aroma and flavour and well balanced acidity.
- 22. Domaine Fourrey – Chablis Premiere Cru** **44.00**
This wine has a fine nose of flint, gunpowder and peach followed by a citrus palate with honeyed silkiness.
- 23. Domaine Vessigaud – Pouilly Fuisse** **46.00**
The nose is a blend of rich citrus fruits, most noticeably lemon, but with underlying raisin, honey and a lovely butterscotch. The palate is equally satisfying, with powerful citrus fruits balanced well with sharp acidity.

Red Wines

- 24. Spier – Pinotage Signature** **19.95**
This classic South African Pinotage has generous red berry fruit and soft tannins.
- 25. Famiglia Pasqua – Valpolicella** **22.00**
A broad fruity nose, with hints of cherries and blackberries. The palate is fresh and well balanced.
- 26. Neptune Point – Marlborough Pinot Noir** **28.00**
This is a smooth and perfectly balanced wine with notes of plum and black cherry.
- 27. Domaine de Matray – Fleurie** **29.50**
Light and one of the most luscious fruity red wines. The nose displays aromas of violets, raspberries and cherries while the palate is fruity and silky.

28. Famiglia Pasqua – Valpolicella Ripasso **33.50**
Ruby red, this wine offers intense aromas of wild cherries, redcurrant and hints of toast with sweet and round tannins on the palate.

29. Quercia al Poggio – Chianti Classico **33.50**
On the nose, rich, intense and complex with aromas of black cherry and spice. The palate is full bodied with rich red berry fruit flavours matched with a backbone of firm tannins.

30. Chateau Vieilles Tour la Rose – St Emilion **37.50**
This wine is nicely ruby red in colour and already open, displaying a very fruity and fresh bouquet with notes of leather and fresh bread. Gorgeously supple on the palate, the tannins are well integrated giving an elegant wine.

31. Chateau Eveline – Lalande de Pomerol **39.00**
This red wine has got intense dark fruit on the nose and palate, with a broad mouthfeel, while at the same time soft and robust. The tannins are very smooth.

32. Famiglia Pasqua – Aarone della Valpolicella **46.00**
Aromas of toast, roasted coffee bean and stewed plum. The solid palate offers dried black cherry, raspberry jam, nutmeg and black pepper alongside the bold tannins.

33. Chateau Gaudin – Pauillac **48.50**
An attractive perfumed wine that expresses both ripe black fruit and great structure, with sweet tannins, delicious fruitiness and a good long finish.

34. Gabriel Liogier – Chateauneuf du Pape **48.50**
A fresh, floral edged style, with soft violet and bergamot notes leading the way for a core of red currant, cherry and damson plum fruit flavours

35. Rivetto – Barolo **69.00**
A native Piedmont grape with a late harvest period, recognized for its quality since the ancient Roman epoch. The wine obtained is characterized by extraordinary refinement, exceptional ageing capacity and bold tannins.
